The Seventh European Workshop in Drug Design will allow 65 participating scientists to work closely with more than 20 leading researchers from both the drug industry and academic institutions to explore solutions to concrete problems encountered in the drug design and discovery process. As in the previous editions (for example [IV EWDD](#), [V EWDD](#) and [VI EWDD](#)), the goal of the Workshop is to help participants to collect, interpret and use experimental data to design new drugs using new methods of molecular modelling in conjunction with synthetic feasibility concepts and metabolic pathways. Interaction of these studies with strategies adopted in the Pharmaceutical Industries, such as high-throughput screening, will be explored.
