Students eligible for selection must be enrolled in undergraduate programs in Economics and Banking and graduate degree programs in International Science at the University of Siena and must have completed at least one year of study within their program.

The selected students are exempt from paying university fees at the host university. Costs of travel, food, housing, and health insurance will be the responsibility of the student. Participants will also be responsible for the costs of books, passports, and other personal costs.

Participants must have insurance coverage that complies with the requirements of the host institutions. Insurance is the responsibility of the exchange student, who may be exempt from the mandatory insurance by the host institution after providing proof of an equivalent form of insurance already held by the participant.

Selected candidates must satisfy the admission requirements of the host university, in particular the requirement concerning language competency.

The host university will inform candidates as soon as possible about their final acceptance.

All participants must have a valid passport and visa for the entire length of the mobility period. The host university will provide all necessary documents to apply for the visa.

Students from the University of Siena studying at the University of West Florida will be located, free of charge, with local families. This housing will be available approximately three days before the start of the semester to the day after the last day of the semester. Students will also have access to the university's dining facilities with a series of meals at variable costs depending on the meal plan.

At the University of West Florida, students from the University of Siena may attend courses within their undergraduate and graduate degree programs, while master students and other types of post-degree students must be approved by the coordinator.

At the end of the academic year, students will receive certification of their work, listing the specific credits and courses successfully completed.
