Exam details	<p>Evaluation of qualifications: candidates’ presence is not required.</p> <p>The admission exam consists in the evaluation by the Committee of the documents presented by candidates, who are not required to take any form of oral or written exam.</p> <p>Minimum score for admission: 60/100</p>
Evaluation of qualifications:	<p>The date for the evaluation of qualifications, for which candidates’ presence is not required, will be published on the website: <a href="http://www.unisi.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca">www.unisi.it/ricerca/dottorati-di-ricerca</a> by clicking on the name of the programme of interest.</p> <p>The evaluation will assign:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- For qualifications: a minimum of 42 points and a maximum of 70 points (up to 40 points for the Cv, up to 20 points for reference letters, up to 10 points for abstract thesis)</li> <li>- For the research projects: a minimum of 18 points and a maximum of 30 points</li> </ul>
