Description of the research project/topic	The PIM project aims to fill a serious gap in the knowledge of the manuscript patrimony transmitting the works of Francesco Petrarca. Unlike the rest of Europe, a complete and homogeneous census for the Italian area is lacking, and the available tools are still partial and insufficient. This testimonial would deserve to be studied not only for the literary but also for the broader intellectual and cultural consequences that Petrarch's works had in the development of Italian and European Humanism. PIM intends to conduct a complete census of the Latin and vernacular manuscripts of Petrarch preserved in Italian libraries and to provide a detailed description of them.

<p>Activities entrusted to the research fellow (ENG)</p>	<p>The Post-doc fellow will be responsible for elaborating the model for manuscript description, both digital and printed, to be used for the census, collaborating with other units and in accordance with the <i>Ente Nazionale Francesco Petrarca</i>. He/she will contribute to the development of a dedicated ontology that enables description, export, and indexing, including images, in formats compatible with the semantic web, effectively implementing the models developed in Cadmus for the ITINERA project. He/she will participate in the census campaign and will be directly responsible for the description of Petrarchan manuscripts, both in Latin and vernacular, held in libraries in Tuscany and northern Italy. They will provide support for the organization of scientific activities within the main unit, collaborating on the revision and publication of the census.</p>
