## Note

## Code of ethics of the university community - article 7 (Conflict of interest)

There is a conflict of interest when the private interest of a member of the University contrasts, even potentially, with the interest, not only economic, of the university. The private interest also refers to the interest of: the spouse or a relative; of persons or entities with which the member of the University has an employment or business relationship; of companies or firms over which they have control or over which they exercise significant influence; of third parties if the member of the University is likely to benefit from it. Anyone who is in conflict of interest with respect to the University refrains from carrying out the relevant acts and reports to the manager of the structure concerned from time to time. The members of the boards refrain from participating in the discussion and deliberation in relation to which they are in conflict of interest, this circumstance being recorded in the minutes. Members of competitive examinations boards, also when external to the University, as soon as it is known to them that among the candidates are the spouse, or cohabitant, relatives or next of kin until the fourth degree, or people with whom they have business relations, shall resign from the Board for incompatibility reasons. All candidates, before the beginning of the competitive procedure, are required to declare under their own responsibility that they have no relations or ties of the type indicated with the members of the commission. Candidates for elective office must declare their membership to associations or organizations whose interests are involved in the activity of the University.
