The minimum score for eligibility is 60/100.</p> <p>Evaluation of qualifications and research project. Candidates are not allowed to be present during the evaluation. Maximum score: 30 The score will be assigned as follows: a) Master's degree grade 110/110 cum laude: 12 points 110/110: 10 points from 108/110 to 109/110: 8 points from 106/110 to 107/110: 6 points from 104/ 110 to 105/110: 4 points up to 103/110: 2 points b) Research project: up to 12 points c) Other qualifications: up to 6 points The minimum score to be admitted to the written examination is 16.</p> <p>Written examination.
