Exam procedures	The overall score is the sum of the scores obtained in the individual assessments and tests. The minimum score for eligibility is 60/100.
	Evaluation of qualifications The presence of candidates is not allowed during the evaluation of qualifications and research project. Score: minimum 18 / maximum 30. The minimum score required to access the written test is 18. In assigning the score, the Commission will take the relevance of the topic of the master's thesis and the research project with respect to the doctoral reference area (10/B1 - History of Art).
	Written test Candidates will be required to historically contextualize and comment on works of art and/or excerpts from art literature and/or art critics and/or museology, selected from a shortlist of options pertaining to Medieval, Modern and Contemporary Art History. Score: minimum 18 / maximum 30. The minimum score for admission to the oral test is 18.
	Interview. The interview will focus on the research project presented. Knowledge of the English language will also be tested. Score: minimum 24 / maximum 40.
