Admission requirements	<b>All masters' degrees</b> ( <i>lauree magistrali, specialistiche, a ciclo unico e vecchio ordinamento</i> )
Exam procedures	<p>The overall score is the sum of the scores obtained in the assessment of qualifications, the research project and the oral interview. The minimum score for eligibility is 60/100.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Evaluation of qualifications: up to a maximum of 50 points,</li> <li>- Research project evaluation: up to a maximum of 20 points,</li> <li>- The minimum score for admission to the interview is 42 points.</li> <li>- Interview: up to a maximum of 30 points, minimum score 18 points</li> </ul> <p>The purpose of the interview is to discuss the submitted research project and to assess the candidate's background, ability and aptitude for scientific research and general knowledge of the research topic, if required. The interview will be conducted online.</p> <p>The results of each test will be published on the PhD website and communicated to the participants by the selection committee.</p>
