	a) Curriculum 1 (Filologia romanza) and Curriculum 2 (Letterature moderne):
	Text analysis
	Candidates will have to prove their historical, philological, critical, and methodological
	competence through the analysis and commentary of a text in verse or prose among the

following scholarly fields: Medieval Romance literature, Medieval Latin literature and humanities (curriculum 1), modern European literatures (curriculum 2).

Candidates may choose from a list of texts.

## b) Position on the research topic "Lessicografia web based dell'italiano antico":

Candidates will have to write an essay on topics related to the Italian language history and philology, with particular focus on lexicographic skills and with reference to the main digital tools commonly used in the discipline.

### c) Position on the research topic "Patrimonio culturale":

Candidates will have to write an essay on the history of literature and criticism of the Italian twentieth century, in view of a doctoral project aimed to critically study the Franco Fortini Archive preserved at the Humanistic Library of the University of Siena.

Minimum score for eligibility: 25 / maximum score: 40

The written tests for the positions with defined research topics will be held on the same day as the written tests for Curricula 1 and 2 but at a different time, to allow applicants to participate in either selection.

#### **EVALUATION OF CV AND RESEARCH PROJECT**

The evaluation will be carried out by the Committee after the correction of the written test and will concern only those candidates who have passed the written test. The presence of candidates is not allowed during the evaluation.

The evaluation of titles (cv, abstract of the master's thesis, letter/s of references) and of the research project, will be carried out according to the following criteria:

- up to a maximum of 6 points for the CV;
- up to a maximum of 15 points for the research project,
- up to a maximum of 4 points for letter/s of references,
- up to a maximum of 5 points for the MA thesis abstract.

Minimum score for eligibility: 18 / maximum score: 30

### **INTERVIEW**

The interview is aimed at verifying the candidates' research skills. Thus, in addition to discussing the written test and completing the assessment of methodological competence, it will focus on the research project. Candidates living abroad who can certify their impossibility to be present at the interview may request to hold it remotely via videoconference. In the latter case, the University of Siena does not assume responsibility for incomplete tests due to technical failures. The Committee will ensure the regularity of the online procedure through an identity check and a correct interview.

The interview for the positions on the research topics "Lessicografia web based" and "Patrimonio culturale" aims at verifying the willingness to accept the research topic and the skills to carry it out.

For all applicants, the interview will include the assessment of the candidates' knowledge of a second foreign language other than English (selected among French, German and Spanish).

Minimum score for eligibility: 17 / maximum score: 30

# B. EVALUATION AND TEST FOR THE POSITION RESERVED TO CANDIDATES WITH A DEGREE OBTAINED IN A FOREIGN INSTITUTION:

#### INTERVIEW

The interview is aimed at verifying the candidates' research skills and will mainly consist in a discussion of her/his research project. It will be held remotely via videoconference unless the candidate requests to be interviewed in presence. The University of Siena does not assume responsibility for incomplete tests due to technical failures. The Committee will ensure the regularity of the online procedure through an identity check and a correct interview.

Minimum score for eligibility: 25 / maximum score: 40

### **EVALUATION OF CV AND RESEARCH PROJECT**

The evaluation will be carried out by the Committee after the interviews and will concern only the candidates who have obtained the minimum score. The presence of candidates is not allowed during the evaluation.

The evaluation of titles (cv, abstract of the master's thesis, letter/s of references) and of the research project, will be carried out according to the following criteria:

- up to a maximum of 12 points for the CV;
- up to a maximum of 30 points for the research project,
- up to a maximum of 8 points for letter/s of references,
- up to a maximum of 10 points for the MA thesis abstract.

Minimum score for eligibility: 35 / maximum score: 60

Applicants for the position reserved to students with a foreign degree are not required to take the written test.

Interviews will be in presence for all candidates except those applying for the position reserved to students with a foreign degree; these latter will receive a communication with the details of the videoconference.
