• English language certification (min. level B2), if any Eligibility of foreign degrees (to be translated into Italian, English or French) is verified by the selection committee in accordance with current regulations and international agreements on the recognition of qualifications for further studies. Candidates who obtained (or will obtain by 31 October 2021) the diploma di laurea from an Italian university have to specify, in their curriculum, all the data about the university career and the title of admission, in particular: the University issuing the title the type of laurea – vecchio ordinamento/specialistica/magistrale; the degree course name the list of examinations with grades the graduation grade and date or expected date of graduation (by 31 October 2021). Candidates who obtained (or will obtain by 31 October 2021) their degree from a foreign university (with a duration of at least four years) have to specify in their curriculum: the university issuing the title the type of degree (min. duration four years) – Bachelor's degree/ Master's degree the graduation grade and date or expected date of graduation (by 31 October 2021). Candidates with a foreign degree have to attach to the online presentation also the following documentation: transcript - certification of the title with the list of exams and grades - with a translation in Italian or English Diploma supplement (if available). The minimum score for eligibility is 60/100. **EVALUATION OF QUALIFICATIONS** Access to evaluation is limited to applications that comply with the aforementioned requirements. The evaluation of qualifications (C.V., thesis, reference letter/s) and of the research project is carried out according to the following criteria: - up to 15 points for the Curriculum Vitae et studiorum - up to 10 points for the thesis - up to 5 points for the reference letter/s - up do 30 points for the research project. The minimum score for eligibility is 36/60. **INTERVIEW** The oral examination aims to assess the applicants' methodological competence and scientific attitude for research and consists of a discussion of their research project, as well as of CV and thesis. In the case of scholarships with topic restrictions the interview aims to ascertain the applicants' willingness and qualifications to pursue the research. The oral examination includes the assessment of the proficiency in a second foreign language (other than English and chosen by applicants) among French, German, Spanish and Russian. The interviews will be held in presence, at the University of Siena, except for the candidates residing abroad, for whom a remote connection will be provided. The

University of Siena disclaims all responsibility for interviews missed or interrupted owing to

	technical failure. The selection committee ensures the fullest respect of the norms regulating public selections, namely identity verification and interview correctness, and the respect of health regulations. The minimum score for eligibility is 24/40.
