



PURPOSE OF THE NOTICE OF SELECTION (Art.1)

- The Overseas mobility programme allows students to spend a semester abroad in one of the partner Universities (Appendix «Overseas Destinations»).
- The mobility is specifically dedicated to mobility in extra-European Countries.
- During the mobility the students will be allowed to attend courses, take exams, and do research (only if allowed by the Host University).



RECIPIENTS (Art.2)

Students of the University of Siena enrolled in a three-year undergraduate programme (Laurea) or in a two-year or single cycle master's programme;

Students at the University of Siena regularly enrolled in a degree programme under the former university regulations

Students of the University of Siena enrolled in a doctoral programme with administrative headquarters in Siena.



BEFORE THE APPLICATION (Art.4)

It is highly recommended to check the academic offer (study plans) of the chosen University, what are the minimum requirements (language requirements, number and type of exams passed, etc.) as well as the application deadline for exchange students at the chosen University.

This may be done by visiting the intended host university's website.



HOW TO APPLY?

Application must be submitted exclusively through the online system (*Segreteria Online*)

Login \Box > International Mobility > Outgoing \Box Mobility > Applications \Box (Select "Accordi Bilaterali")

Some universities only admit exchange students enrolled in specific fields of study or degree courses; for this reason, students may have a limited choice of destination in the online application.



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS (Art.6)

Knowledge of a foreign language will be evaluated for each destination based on the language requirement of the university selected by the candidate.

All students should check the published language requirement for each of the host universities they wish to apply to.

APPLICATION EVALUATION (Art.5)

Applications are ranked by the sum of their points from:

- **1.** Academic merit (max 30 points)
- 2. Language requirements (max 30 points)
- Academic fit of the candidate's motivation (max 30 points)

FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION (Art.8)

Successful applicants will receive a scholarship based on their ISEE (an indicator of personal income) according to the following table:

ISEE	Monthly mobility grant
$ISEE \leq 13.000$	€ 500
$13.000 < ISEE \le 21.000$	€ 450
21.000 < ISEE ≤ 26.000	€ 400
$26.000 < ISEE \le 30.000$	
$30.000 < ISEE \le 40.000$	€ 350
$40.000 < ISEE \le 50.000$	
ISEE>50.000
