PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Department / Function	Language Learning Centres, part of the Languages Service (on Blasco Ibáñez Campus, Burjassot Campus and Els Tarongers Campus). Working from home may be necessary if the health authorities or the University itself restrict access to the campus. Distance mobilities, i.e. conducted from outside Valencia, are not possible.
Description of activities	We are looking for six candidates for a traineeship placement at our self-access language learning centres which will consist of: -Leading conversation groups at our language learning centres. -Correcting and/or producing language learning material. 3 trainees will perform these activities in English; 1 in French; 1 in German; and 1 in Italian.
Location	Valencia [Spain].
Duration	9 months (1.9.22–31.5.23). Exceptionally, we may accept shorter stays.
Working hours per week	30 (Monday to Thursday or Tuesday to Friday), of which approx. 10-11 hours dedicated to leading conversation groups.
Working languages	Our Service uses Catalan as its working language. All teaching-related activities conducted by the trainee will be in target language (i.e. English, French, Italian, German, etc. as applicable). You will receive day-to-day support in English, French, German, Catalan or Spanish, as appropriate.

Financial support	500 euros/month (approx. 430 euros after tax). This stipend will be paid <i>in addition</i> to the Erasmus+ Traineeship programme grant (amount varies, approx. 350-470 euros/month) or similar funding granted as part of a mobility programme offered by the sending institution prior to the commencement of the traineeship.
Training	Training to become a conversation group leader. Catalan language training to support your stay available at all levels. Tutoring will be the responsibility of the foreign language specialist on each campus.

Optional further training	Discounted or free cultural and language-related activities organised by the Language Policy Service are available. Activities offered by other services are available, but may be subject to a fee.
Liability insurance	<p>Upon arrival, the University of Valencia requires trainees to certify they – or their home universities on their behalf – have taken out accident and civil liability insurance covering injury to the trainee and civil liability for bodily or material harm caused involuntarily to third parties during the period. Trainee status	<p>Please note that trainee staff are not considered students and as such are not eligible for certain discounts offered only to Erasmus studies, among which discounts on Spanish classes. The additional remuneration we offer seeks to compensate any extra costs you may incur as a result. Trainees receive a university card granting access to library and other university services.</p>
Advice for successful candidates	<p>Before payments of UV financial support can begin, you will need to obtain an ID number in Spain. We will help you, however we strongly recommend successful candidates come to Valencia early, in order to find suitable accommodation and complete the paperwork on time.</p>
