

ADDITIONAL SPECIFICATIONS TO THE GUIDELINES OF 25 FEBRUARY 2021

Following the recent provisions of the Tuscany Region, which includes the province of Siena into the so-called "Red zone", taking into account the provisions for universities by the current Prime Ministerial Decree of 14 January 2021 (art. 3, c. 4, let. g) and in accordance with the indications of the Regional Coordination Committee of the Tuscan Universities of 14 November, it is confirmed that the Guidelines issued by the Academic Senate last 25 February maintain their validity (https://www.unisi.it/sites/default/files/allegatiparagrafo/Communication_Senate_25022021.pdf).

In particular, in accordance with the organization plans of the teaching and training activities of each program, the following activities can be carried out in the presence:

- courses for specializing medical doctors, including internships;
- specific training courses in general medicine, including internships;
- internships of any program in the medical area;
- curricular internships of other study and specialization courses that are not actually completely feasible at a distance;
- any other experiential activities that cannot be replaced with remote activities (for example, teaching laboratories, tutorials, field excursions and internships aimed at preparing the degree, doctoral and specialization thesis);
- doctoral research activities, such as research seminars.

Access to library services, including loan and return, as well as access to the study rooms is allowed from Monday to Friday to all staff of the University of Siena, including PhD students, postdocs, fellows, students.

In compliance with the travel prohibitions indicated in the aforementioned Prime Ministerial Decree, study rooms will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

The aforementioned provisions are enforced starting tomorrow, February 27, and are valid until the province of Siena remains in the red zone.

Taking into account the worrisome evolution of the local pandemic situation, maximum caution is still recommended in attending university complexes and full compliance with the safety rules defined in the shared regulatory protocol of measures to contrast and contain the spread of COVID-19 in environments of the University of Siena, available at the following link:
