The UN SDSN Center for Mediterranean - MED Solutions

The United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network, directed by Professor Jeffrey D. Sachs (Earth Institute, Columbia University), is a new independent global network of research centers, universities and technical institutions to help find solutions for some of the world's most pressing environmental, social and economic problems.

The UN SDSN works with stakeholders including business, civil society, UN agencies and other international organizations to identify and share the best pathways to achieve sustainable development.

Under the umbrella of the UN SDSN, the University of Siena has become the first Regional SDSN Center, with the name MED Solutions.

MED Solutions will act as a regional hub and will coordinate the activities of a network of universities, research centers and businesses interested in identifying and promoting Solutions Initiatives in the Mediterranean Region.

The Conference Sustainable Development Solutions for the Mediterranean Region

As a first step, the University of Siena will convene two conferences on "Sustainable Development Solutions for the Mediterranean Region".

The first conference will take place in Pontignano from 3 to 5 July 2013 focusing on identifying and adopting a first set of Solution Initiatives.

University Rector Angelo Riccaboni and Professor Jeffrey Sachs will lead the conference. It will bring together a unique combination of high-level experts, policy makers, managers, civil society leaders, academics and students from key Mediterranean institutions. For this conference, a call for proposals has been opened and is accessible through the MED Solutions website: http://www.medsolutions.unisi.it/call-for-proposals.

The Solutions Initiatives should be practical project proposals involving novel technologies, business models, institutional mechanisms and/or policies that are promising yet unproven. They should address a well-defined set of problems, have a transformative impact on sustainable development and be scalable following a successful demonstration.

They must be technically feasible and implementable within a reasonable timeframe without the need for primary research.

A second conference will be organized one year after the first (in 2014) in Pontignano to review progress on the first set of Solution Initiatives.
