FURTHER INFORMATION ON UNIVERSITY ACTIVITIES AFTER APRIL 6TH 2021

Considering the evolution of the epidemiological situation recorded in Tuscany and of the indications contained in the decree 31 March 2021, the Senatorial Commission in charge of monitoring the actions to be taken to deal with the pandemic in the University has decided to maintain the Guidelines already approved by the Academic Senate on 25 February 2021:

We therefore remind you that all in-presence teaching activities are suspended and that lectures will take place exclusively at-distance. All laboratory activities may be held in-presence, in strict compliance with safety measures. At the request of the teacher and in agreement with the students, the Heads of the department can authorize in-presence of teaching activities (in parallel with live streaming) for courses with a small number of students.

The departments, research laboratories, libraries and reading rooms remain open, also for using the WiFi, and maintaining the access limitations to authorized users only (employees, students, PhD students, postgraduates from the University of Siena), for which it will be necessary to register their entrances to the buildings.

All authorized users are required to behave correctly, respecting safety measures and avoiding gatherings.

These guidelines will remain in effect until further notice.
